

Photo-voice Contest Rules

Please see below for full context details. Participation in this contest indicates your full understanding and acceptance of these contest rules. As a participant, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

Contest Timeframe and Organization

The Photo-voice contest (“contest”) is held by Nunavummi Disabilities Makinnasuaqtiit Society (“contest organizer”) and runs from October 1, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. until October 30th, 2020 at 5:00 p.m (“contest timeframe”).

Eligibility

The contest is open to all Nunavummiut and Nunavummi Organizations who have either reached 19 years of at the time of entry, or have parental consent stated in the entry form. Participation is not allowed for any and all employees of the contest organizer or the contest organizer’s funding partners.

Personal Information

Photographs must be submitted with an entry form that includes information such as: name, address, and parental permission (If under 19 years of age). This information allows for the contest organizer to provide the winners with their prize and name the winning photographers. The contest organizer will not share personal information with anyone else. The contest organizer will not contact participants for any purpose beyond the contest itself.

How to Enter

To participate in the contest, you must take an original photograph that shows either a barrier to participation in your community, or an example of accessibility within your community. NO PHOTOGRAPHS OF PEOPLE with exception to the entry participant. Your entry must include an entry form that states your name, address, and a brief description of why this photograph is important to you and any changes you would make. The entry form includes a very simple skill testing question for the random prize draw.

You have three submission options, you may:

Format of Photographs Submission

Entries submitted through mail or in person must be in digital format on a USB. Accepted file formats include .JPEG, .tiff, and .png. The maximum upload size for photo submission is 10MB. The content of the photograph cannot be changed, however cropping and colour corrections are acceptable. The photographs that are selected for the calendar need a high-resolution version for best quality (uncompressed .tiff file, or maximum quality .JPEG). Participants who cannot produce high-resolution versions will be eliminated from the calendar publication. The contest organizer will give participants time to provide high-resolution versions with special consideration to their location and delivery options.

Prizes

All entries will be included in a random draw for one of our many community prizes. Examples of prizes to be won are: camping gear, fishing rods, and natural seal skin. The odds of winning the random draw depend on the number of eligible entries received during the contest timeframe. Twelve photographs will then be chosen by a judging committee to be published in a calendar. On November 6, 2020, the contest organizer will announce the winners of the random draw as well as the judging committee's selected photographs. The prizes cannot be exchanged or transferred to someone else.

Publication

The twelve selected photographs will be published in a calendar that promotes awareness for disabilities. By submitting a photograph, the participant gives ownership of the image to the contest organizer for non-exclusive and perpetual right and license to reproduce, publish, and distribute the image in print or in digital formats such as the NDMS website or social media platforms. In the event that the photograph belongs to someone under 19 years of age, parental consent is required on the entry form and must be given in order to collect a prize

Judging

The twelve photographs will be reviewed and selected by a committee. All decisions of the judging committee are final. If winning participants are unable to provide high-resolution images for publication, the judging committee reserves the right to claim ineligibility and a new participant will be chosen. Judges will make their decisions based on the quality of the photo and will do their best to include a variety of content and regional representations to avoid duplication.

Responsibility

The contest organizer is not responsible for any malfunction of any computer component, software, or line of communication with respect to network connectivity, faulty or incomplete transmission, and lost or damaged submissions either directly or indirectly. The contest

organizer is not responsible for any bodily harm, loss or damages caused by participation or resulting from acceptance, possession or misuse of a prize.

General

For subjects that are not included in these contest rules, the decision of the contest organizer is final without appeal. By entering into the contest, participants declare that they have read and understand these contest rules. This contest is subject to all applicable laws and regulations. In the event of a disagreement concerning these contest rules, between the participant and the contest organizer, the laws of the territory of Nunavut will decide. If a section of these contest rules is declared invalid, the remaining sections will be applied in accordance with the law.
